Job Title: Watershed Technician (Full-Time, Temporary One-Year with Potential for Permanent)

The Walla Walla Basin Watershed Council is seeking a motivated Watershed Technician to join our team. This position is a full-time, temporary position for one year, with the possibility of transitioning into a permanent role based on performance and organizational needs. The successful candidate will be key to our fieldwork crew, supporting various habitat surveys, restoration projects, and surface and groundwater monitoring program.

- Conduct field surveys, gather data, and monitor outcomes of ongoing restoration work.
- Participate in on-site assessments, collect environmental samples, and document findings.
- Provide field support, coordinate with project partners, and help implement restoration activities.
- Assist with habitat improvement tasks, project monitoring, and related restoration efforts.
- Perform data collection and inventory on spring sources and coordinate with team members for accurate reporting.
- Support ongoing monitoring efforts, maintain accurate records, and ensure data integrity.
